Rules and Regulations for Junior Members of the D.C.F.D

The following rules and regulations shall pertain to all Junior members of the Dunn's Corners Fire Department. Junior Members are those member who are between the ages of 14 and 18 who have applied for and been accepted as Junior Members by the DCFD. These rules shall apply while the junior member is attending any department functions and incidents:

- I. Duties during drills and parades. (Under supervision)
 - A. Assist pump operator if needed.
 - B. Check hose lines for leaks.
 - C. Change Scott bottles.
 - D. Attend trainings such as drills and work parties.
 - E. Vehicle maintenance only under supervision.
 - F. Must wear all Junior Member turnout gear, properly marked as such.

- II. Duties at fire or incident scene. (Under supervision)
 - A. Report to Dunn's Corners Engine nearest scene, or to Incident Command Post, if one is set up.
 - B. Assist around engine(s).
 - C. Check hoses for leaks from engine to water source.
 - D. Change Scott bottles.
 - E. Assist in outdoor mop-up, or at a Chief's discretion, indoor overhaul after the fire is out only under supervision.
 - F. Assist in drafting and shuttling of water.
 - G. Must wear all Junior Member turnout gear, properly marked as such.

- III. Prohibited at fire incident scene.
 - A. Can not enter a burning structure.
 - B. Should be no closer than a DCFD engine at vehicle fires.
 - C. Can not climb ladders.
 - D. Can not man hose lines at structure fires. May man hose line at vehicle fire scene only at officer's discretion, provided all victims are out of vehicle. May man hose line at brush fire only at officer's discretion.
 - E. Can not ride on rear step or any portion of the outside of a moving vehicle at any time.
 - F. Can not drive or move any DCFD apparatus.
 - G. Can not engage in traffic control at a fire or incident scene.

The following action will be taken if the preceding rules are broken:

- 1st Offense: Verbal warning with one Chief and training officer.
- 2nd Offense: Suspension for one week, but no more than one month at the discretion of the Board of Engineers.
- 3rd Offense: Punishment to be determined by the Board of Engineers, with a maximum of suspension for one year from all fire department functions/activities.

All offenses will be recorded on the Junior Member's record.

Due to the nature of firefighting, training, and the variety of incidents encountered, these rules and regulations may be waived at the discretion of the senior DCFD officer present at a scene, activity, drill, or function.
